1. ARRIVE ON TIME (EARLY)

Immigration can deny your application if you fail to appear on time, so plan to arrive at least 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment.

2. DRESS NICELY

3. TELL THE TRUTH

You must assume that Immigration already knows what the truth is, so tell the truth.

4. BE READY

Know what you are applying for, why you are eligible for it, and why the documentation you are providing supports it.

5. BE CONFIDENT

You look nice, you are telling the truth, and you are ready, so look at the Immigration officer in the eyes, speak clearly, and confidently answer all of the questions that are being asked.
